



Explanations of the sports programme

A CSI5* show jumping competition is an international show jumping competition of the highest category according to the regulations of the Fédération Équestre Internationale (FEI) and is classified by its five stars as an event with the highest sporting and organisational requirements.

A CSIYH1* competition is an international show jumping competition in accordance with FEI regulations. The abbreviation CSIYH stands for Concours de Saut International - Young Horses, whereby the addition 1^* refers to the entry level within this show series.

A CPEDI test is an international para-dressage test in accordance with FEI regulations and is aimed at equestrian classified athletes with disabilities. It is divided into grades I-V, depending on the functional ability of the riders.
